Nature experience and tree planting

Love Forest Finland is a concept implemented in accordance with the values of Mood of Finland Company: Creative, Inspiring, Responsible – together with others, in good mood.

Tree planting is part of the forest experience which includes forest walk in silence and picnic by an open campfire. Traditional and seasonal food and beverage is served.

Forest mindfulness exercises can be included to the forest walk. Services are offered in cooperation with other entrepreneurs.

Love Forest is both a physical place – named as Love Forest – where symbolic trees can be planted, and a forest made up of the trees planted first around Finland and since 2022 globally. The concept consists of planting trees as symbol of love and care and of donating money for nature conservation. Certificates can be purchased in online shop and 10€ of each certificate is donated to conserve old forests.

Love Forest Finland concept encourages planting trees with a story. Planting your own symbolic tree of love, dedicated to someone or to some cause important to you, strengthens the relationship with nature and connects people to nature's history and future.

We organize open tree planting events and events to take off the alien species to raise awareness of biodiversity and nature loss. These encounters promote a sense of community among the villagers and visitors

Energy

Mood of Finland company does not have a permanent office. The home office's electricity is produced with renewable energy and the space is heated with an energy-efficient air source heat pump.

Waste

All waste is sorted and recycled (mixed waste, bio, paper, cardboard, plastic, bottles and cans, metal). From the nature excursions all waste is brought along and sorted.

Event participants are encouraged to use public transport or carpooling, and we also act according to the same principle. When driving, we use renewable bio-diesel

Mood of Nature experiences invite you to peaceful forest excursions, respecting nature. We maintain the silence and observe nature. We walk only on marked and licensed routes, respecting everyone's rights and obligations valid in Finland. No motorized vehicles are used in nature. If the participant so wishes, we do forest mind exercises. We want to remind that our task is to increase the well-being of the individual, the community and nature
